Annual Scientific Meeting 2009

The Annual Scientific Meeting will be held on 23rd Oct 2009 to 25th Oct 2009 at Shaw Auditorium, Postgraduate Education Center, Prince of Wales Hospital, Shatin, Hong Kong.

This year we invited Professor Steven G Silverberg from the University of Maryland and Professor Christopher DM Fletcher from the Harvard University as our speakers.

Topics and speakers:

1. Professor Silverberg's topics:

- Borderline tumors of ovary
- Prognostic factors on ovarian cancer.
- Metastatic carcinoma to the ovary

2. Professor Fletcher's topics:

- Problems of prognostic predictors of soft tissue tumors.
- Haemangiopericytoma: evolution of the concept.
- Recently characterized soft tissue tumors.
- Differential diagnosis of myxoid soft tissue tumors.

The presenting authors for abstract or slide presentation must register for the meeting. Deadline for submission (for both Abstract and Slide Presentation) is

Attendants can be accredited up to 14 CME points by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists for the entire program.
