The course fee is HK\$300. It will be waived if members register for the **special package deal**.

Special Package Deal

Registration for package deal (\$2540 for fellows/qualified pathologists and \$1760 for residents/trainees) includes membership, Histopathology Course 2003 and Surgical Pathology Update 2003 (see below).

Annual Scientific Meeting 2003

Surgical Pathology Update 2003 - co-organized by the Hong Kong Division of IAP and M.D. Anderson Cancer Center

This year's ASM will be a 3-full day event organized jointly with M.D. Anderson Cancer Center at Prince of Wales Hospital, Shatin, Hong Kong between 10th and 12th October inclusive. The program will include lectures and slide seminar to be given by Dr. John K.C. Chan (on haematopathology) and 8 speakers from M.D. Anderson Cancer Centre:

Dr. Janet Bruner	on neuropathology
Dr. Anais Malpcia	on endometrial and cervical pathology
Dr. Cesar Moran	on thoracic pathology
Dr. Victor Prieto	on dermatopathology
Dr. Kevin Raymond	on orthopedic pathology
Dr. Elvio Silva	on ovarian pathology
Dr. Nour Sniege	on breast and cytopathology

The registration fee* for full-paying qualified/fellow participants for the 3-day course will be HK\$2340 (or US\$300) and that for residents/trainees will be HK\$1560 (or US\$200).

Day registration fee for full-paying qualified/fellow participants and residents/trainees are HK\$1170 (or US\$150) and HK\$780 (or US\$100) respectively.

*Lunch and tea-breaks are included in the registration fee. 20% additional fee will be charged for late registrations after 1st August 2003.

A number of slide sets consisting of 18 glass slides from the slide seminar cases are available for purchase at HK\$468 (US\$60).

An optional congress dinner will be held in the evening of 11th October, 2003 (Saturday). This will include transportation from Shatin, 1 ½ hours of harbour cruise with free drinks, and seafood dinner on Lamma Island. The cost will be HK\$624 (US\$80).

Participants can be accredited 20.5 CME points by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists for the full program.
