A **Resident Slide Presentation session** will be held on October 21, 2005 (10-15 minutes per case). All residents are strongly encouraged to participate. For case submission, please send 15 H&E recuts together with a short abstract (200 words) to the **Meeting Secretariat**. Prizes will be awarded for best slide presentation(s).

The presenting authors for abstract or slide presentation must register for the meeting. Deadline for submission (for both Abstract and Slide Presentation) is September 5, 2005. The authors will be informed of the adjudication before September 20, 2005. For further details and submission format, please visit our website <http://www.hkiap.org>.

Attendants can be accredited up to 18 CME points by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists for the program.

Registration fee for 14th ASM:
