The Annual Scientific Meeting will be held on December 1-3, 2006 at Shaw Auditorium, Postgraduate Education Center, Prince of Wales Hospital, Shatin, Hong Kong.

- 2) Cutaneous non-melanocytic neoplasms
- 3) Important issues in contemporary dermatopathology

The **Abstract platform/poster Presentation session** (on any subject in anatomic pathology) will take place on December 1, 2006; all participants are

encouraged to submit abstracts. Prize(s) will be awarded for best trainee presentation(s). Only electronic submission by email will be accepted. Please send the WORD file of abstract to the **Meeting Secretariat.**

A **Resident Slide Presentation session** will be held on December 1, 2006 (10-15 minutes per case). All residents are strongly encouraged to participate. For case submission, please send 15 H&E recuts together with a short abstract (200 words) to the **Meeting Secretariat.** Prizes will be awarded for best slide presentation(s).

The presenting authors for abstract or slide presentation must register for the meeting. Deadline for submission (for both Abstract and Slide Presentation) is <u>October 31, 2006</u>. The authors will be informed of the adjudication before November 15, 2006. For further details and submission format, please visit our website http://www.hkiap.org.

Attendants can be accredited up to 15 CME points by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists for the entire program.

Registration fees:
