The presenting authors for abstract or slide presentation must register for the meeting. Deadline for submission (for both Abstract and Slide Presentation) is 31st August, 2007. Attendants can be accredited up to 14 CME points by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists for the entire program.

Registration fees:

Histopathology course:
