








Now available - Online Digital Mock IAC Examination

IAC Digital Examinations

- The CT(IAC) comprehensive cytotechnology examination
- IAC International Board of Cytopathology examination for medical members (MIAC).
- The two IAC examinations will be held digitally. Participants will be asked to bring their own laptops or tablets to the examination site.
- The first digital examination in Hong Kong will be held on Monday, 4. December at the Prince of Wales Hospital.
- Over 30 cytotechs are registered.

Membership Initials

Medical Membership (MIAC)

Mandatory requirements:

- 1. Medical degree and CV indicating medical education
- 2. Completed education in a **medical specialty** in your country of residence (e.g. pathology, gynaecology, internal medicine etc.)
- 3. Special expertise in cytology
- 4. Two **sponsorship signatures** from IAC Members and/or Fellows
- 5. Completed application form and Photograph
- 6. Application forms available on-line at the IAC website



Fellowship Elevation (FIAC)

Mandatory requirements for Candidates:

- 1. Members (MIAC) of at least two years may apply to sit the voluntary IAC International Board of Cytopathology examination.
- 2. The **Examination fee** is 450 Euro, annual dues remain at 190 Euro.
- 3. Successful candidates are elevated to Fellow (FIAC) and may keep the Fellow of the IAC status for the duration of membership

The CT(IAC) Comprehensive Cytotechnology Registry Examination

- For over 50 years, the IAC has administered examinations at the request of national cytology societies world wide.
- Cytotechnologists from over 65 countries have taken the examination.
- As of April 2023 more than 12,000 cytotechnologists have obtained the CT(IAC) title, after passing the IAC Comprehensive Cytotechnology Examination and may use the letter CT(IAC) after their name.



How To: Exam and Registration

The Goal of the Examination is to Determine:

- Knowledge related to **the criteria of malignancy** for most body sites
- The ability to determine, with some degree of accuracy, the expected diognostic entity
- The ability to **seperate malignant from nonmalignant** cells
- The ability to to select those cases that should be seen by a cytopathlogist from those cases that can be signed out as negative.

Cytotechnologist Membership (CMIAC)

 Cytotologist membership (CMIAC) is open to all who have passed the registry examination
